4-Hour Confined Spacing Training

COURSE DESCRIPTION: OSHA has developed a new standard for construction workers entering Confined Spaces (29CFR 1926 Subpart-AA). This new standard was passed on May 4, 2015 and became effective on August 3, 2015. All construction workers must be trained to safety work in Confined Spaces. A **confined space** has limited or restricted means for entry or exit, and it is not designed for continuous employee occupancy. **Confined spaces** include, but are not limited to underground vaults, tanks, storage bins, manholes, pits, silos, process vessels, and pipelines. Upon completion of the course students will have a basic understanding of **confined space** hazards and how to work in a confined space environment to maximize safety for you and those around you. Students will receive a certificate of completion.
